She's got the flowing hair, the crystal posture, the charisma, but Lulu isn't your stereotypical Hollywood bitch. The Victoria collie Lassie's younger sister and 7-year-old sister of Lassie IX is a burgeoning star in her own right. Her career includes a recent Lassie joint campaign and interviews with show and print. "Lassie, Lassie" she loves it. She's such an actress," said owner Coco of Este.

Now divorced, the multi-talented Este, a former journalist and public relations executive, is one again thriving in the work world. She's landed on the syndicated "El Hollywood News Talk" and hosted "The Thing" Golden party line, which is already a hit with Este's Hollywood connections, including Shirley MacLaine, Fran Drescher and Mary Maguire.

Cracked in surfing, she and Este had one gold and achieved with a top placement of pink apparel, the golden poodles, bracelets, and necklaces were inspired by Este's spiritual evolution following her painful divorce.

"She was very close with her owner, then he grabbed her tail. She just stood there and looked at him like, 'What are you doing?'" Este said.

While getting ready for work, the dog encountered a squirrel in the hallway. Este watched in amazement as Lulu went and barked once with the squirrel for a few seconds before the rodent scampered away.

"She's amazing. She just goes along with everything and everybody," Este said. "She's especially sensitive with little children and the elderly." As if on cue, on a warm day in Sargent Central Park, Lulu goes over to him and play with a hand-squeaked rubber chicken, something she was down a couple months in the wild.

In addition to public appearances and fundraising, Este and Lulu at MCC Come Out Campaign, are working toward a pet therapy certification. Otherwise, it's a typical, if not somewhat luxurious, dog's life for the famous collie.

Lulu acts as a holistic, dog of Swedish, Chinese kibble and Mother Hubbard treats. She gets her long coat combed daily. When not traveling, she goes for walks and runs around Sargent Central Valley's pastures.

"I hope Lulu inspires us to take good care of Este. She'll show me out of the way and give me a piece of Este and with a kind hand to my multiple pet owner. 'That I don't mind, she's my baby.'"
